What is the “Show Me” Poster?

- A team poster that shares what you learned during the PLAYMAKERS season!
- A space to describe your team journey throughout the meetings/ sessions.
- You can use words, drawings, and photos on your poster.

Explore

- What did students learn?
- How did they learn this information?
- What research was done to support your obstacle course design?

Create & Test

- How did you create your obstacle course?
- What did you program and why?
- How did you test your model and program?

Share

- What do you want to share about your team?
- How did you share what you learned?
- Who did you share it with?

How can we make a digital “Show Me” poster? While teams could make a physical poster, it will be difficult to share at a Remote Event. Here are some guidelines to get you started...

- A digital “Show Me” poster should still share your teams journey and what you learned: Remember... Explore, Create & Test, and Share!
- You can still use text, drawings, and photos... you can also include short video clips!
- Here are a few platforms your team can use to create a digital poster:
