Virtual Pit Instructions

A virtual pit is an online display (image, PDF, website, etc) that showcases your team's work. Just like a physical pit area at a competition, teams might want to display their robot, innovation project, or other elements that are unique to their team. Just because we can't meet in person, doesn't mean we cannot celebrate the work of all teams! When submitting materials, teams will have the option to submit a link to their virtual pit which will be posted and made available to all event participants!

Teams sometimes post a team picture or logo, a robot game round, details about their robot, or their innovation project presentation! It is really up to the team as to what they would like to showcase.

Virtual Pits...

- Showcase the accomplishments of the team
- Are visual and easy to navigate
- Represent the team's season (think of our Core Values)
- Are a fun way to learn about other teams!

Ideas of what teams can include...

- Link to Robot Game round
- Images/ details of team robot
- Link to Innovation Project Presentation
- Pictures of team practices or activities
- Team picture
- Team Logo
- How the team uses Core Values
- Favorite part of the season

The format is flexible. Teams could submit a link to a PDF, slide show, image, website, etc. One of the easiest ways to create a Virtual Pit is through Google Slides.
